This Indenture of declaration of public charitable Trust be Known as CHITRANSH SANJAY EDUCATIONAL & COMMUNITY WELFARE TRUST is made on this 19th April, 2022 by Mr. Sanjay kumar Srivastava S/o S.C Srivastava resident of Duplex No. 4 Ambedkar Vihar Colony Chauphatka Prayagraj, Adhar No.-670594333142 & Mobile 9415218326 author of trust (herein after called the founder Trustee). Whereas the founder trustee being social worker

always had an earnest desire to serve the society, so as that they may be able to set up better standard of living and thereby rise and develop socially and economically. Mission of **TRUST** is to contribute to nurturing people who make effort for betterment of Community with spirit of "Love God, love people, and love Soil"

CHITRANSH SANJAY EDUCATIONAL & COMMUNITY WELFARE TRUST is aiming to contribute betterment of society and people through of integrated sustainable development towards self-help and self reliance.

And whereas the founder trustee have initially started the trust with an irrevocable sum of **Rs. 510,000/-** and declare the said amount as trust Corpus Fund being Rs. 10000 in cash/bank and Rs. 500000 land value situated at village Dhokri, Tahsil phulpur, District Prayagraj.

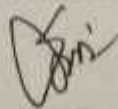
Now this trust deed witnessed as under:-

1. That the funder trustee declares that the Trust emerging out of the deed always be known as **CHITRANSH SANJAY EDUCATIONAL & COMMUNITY WELFARE TRUST**.
2. The registered office of the trust shall be **Duplex No. 4 Ambedkar Vihar Colony Chauphatka Prayagraj** or at any other place or places that the trustees may decide from time to time.

The main Objectives of the Trust is as Follows:



- i. To establish run, develop or improve any school, college or other educational and/ or technical institution or adopt, assist or help any existing education and/ or technical institution without profit motive for the benefit of public in India.
- ii. To undertake, promote, assist or engage in all kinds of research and development work required to promote, assist or engaged in setting up Educational institutions and hospitals.
- iii. To undertake, sponsor applied and action research and study programmers on socially relevant themes namely medical, education, promotion of humanitarism etc.
- iv. To organize programs and classes to improve the status of deprived community in the area of education, health, environmental awareness, literature, classical and folk music/ art, craft etc.
- v. To sponsor research and to grant scholarships, loans, travel grants, prizes, samman and/for meritorious/deserving scholars.
- vi. To edit, print, publish and distribute good research books, text, pamphlets, reports, studies and other publications with no profit or subsidizes cost in the area of Education, Social sciences, Cultural programmers, Literature, etc.
- vii. To establish and maintain libraries, information and documentation centers, including audio-visual,



computer based educational materials, natural resources centers, etc.

- viii. To undertake academic research as well as socio economic programmers for the weaker section of the society viz, tribal, schedule casts, elderly women, widows and children, senior citizens and also to render training in respect of these fields.
- ix. To Provide facilities for the exchange of opinions and views, techniques, practices, trends and for stimulating thought on subject of interest of the Trust.
- x. To cooperate with professionals from medical, educational, research, financial, industrial institutions and governmental and other organizations for collection and exchange of information.
- xi. To undertake all or any agricultural, educational, and other developmental and social welfare services conducive to the aim and objects of the Trust.
- xii. To setup laboratories, purchase and acquire any equipments and instruments required for carrying out medical and educational research.
- xiii. To educate and give training to students medical and engineering students, nurses, midwives and hospital administrator, and to grant such diplomas/degrees or recognitions as the Trust may prescribes or deem fit from time to time.

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- xiv. To grant stipend, scholarships or any other assistance or otherwise to deserving students or scholars, to further the courses of medicine and/or medical/educational research.
 - xv. To setup blood banks and eye banks on the basis of voluntary donations.
 - xvi. To provide preventive and curative services to all persons irrespective of cost, creed, colour, religion or language.
 - xvii. To establish and maintain projects and branches thereof for the said purpose at such place or places as may be decided by the Trustees from time to time.
 - xviii. To accept donations (in cash or kind), subscriptions, grants, presents and to collect dividends, rents interest and other income of the Trust fund etc. from Individuals, Associations Governments, National and International donor/corporate organizations for being utilized to further the object thereof.
 - xix. To construct, maintain, alter, improve, or develop any building/ buildings or works necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Trust.
 - xx. To do, or get done, all such things as are conducive or incidental to the attainment of said objects.
3. That the trust will have minimum 2 and maximum 8 Trustee members.



4. That the founder trustee **Shri. Sanjay Kumar Srivastava S/o S.C. Srivastava** will be life time chief executive of the trust and only can be remove from office only by his written resignation, then only will cease to continue as chief executive.
5. In case if any subsequent Chief Trustee is appointed, it will be elected for a term of five years by two third majority votes of trust members.
6. Only legal heirs/successors of present trustees of this deed will be appointed as trustee in future.
7. Only founder trustee can appoint/nominate new trustee to this trust.
8. All the legal heirs/successors of founder trustee will be the life time members of this trust.
9. Any trustee can resign on one month notice subject to approval by two third members of all trustees.
10. Any of the existing trustees can be removed by only founder trustee on one month notice.
11. The trustees alone shall have power to repeal, amend and modify the Trust objective.
12. The Trustees shall not be entitled to receive any remuneration for acting as trustees but they shall be entitled to get reimbursement of the expenses incurred by them actually in connection with and in favour of the trust or their duties relating thereto and also to get reasonable remuneration for services rendered by them



13. The surplus generated from the activities of the trust shall be the trust fund and it will never be shared between/amongst the trustees.
14. The Master Aarush Srivastava, aged about 14 years, S/o Shri. Sanjay Kumar Srivastava, will be admitted to the trust as one of the trustee upon attaining the age of majority i.e.18 years.
15. The founder trustee **Shri. Sanjay Kumar Srivastava** has added another four Trustee members as per the following details.

POWER AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARES

1) PRESIDENT-

- A)The President shall organize the meeting of Trust time to time.
- B)He/She can search the financial assistance for the objective of Trust.

2) VICE PRESIDENT:

- A)The vice president of the trust shall enjoy all the powers of the President in his/her powers.
- B)In the absence of President, Vice President shall organize the meeting.

3) CHIEF TRUSTEE

- A)The Founder trustee/Chief Trustee shall represent on behalf of the trust for welfare of the trust, to raise funds, to start the project, to establish the programs and to meet with its objectives.
- B)Founder trustee/Chief Trustee will summon and on the meetings of the governing body and General body.
- C)Founder trustee/Chief Trustee will prepare the Memebrship Register as well as the proceedings Register to record the minutes of the proceeding of the governing body meeting and the



general body meeting and have them duly signed by the members who attend the meetings.

D) Founder trustee/chief Trustee shall undertake all type of correspondence on behalf of the Trust.

E) Founder trustee/chief Trustee shall perform all other duties as may be assigned to him/her.

F) Founder trustee shall be the chief officer of the Trust and he/she will be empowered to appoint, suspend the members, trustees and employees of the trust.

G) Founder trustee/chief Trustee shall be empowered for account operation with his/her signature as single entity. and thoroughly responsible for all the activities of the trust. Founder trustee/Chief Trustee shall also be empowered to open and run bank account jointly with another office bearer or trustee or member or employee as required to meet with objectives of the trust.

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4) TRESURER:

A) Treasurer shall maintain the accounts of all money received and/or paid by him/her on behalf of Trust.

B) Treasurer shall make disbursement in accordance with the direction of the governing body.

5) OTHER Members-

A) The others members have play additional role according to need of the Trust.

16. The office of the trust is Duplex No. 4 Ambedkar Vihar Colony Chauphatka Prayagraj and its branches may be in whole republic of India according to the need of the Trust.

17. That the aforesaid sum of Rs. 510,000/- only in future and other property and money shall hereafter be the "Trust property" where of the founder trustee above said have jointly put in collective possession and they shall as such trustee, own, possess and manage the property to fulfill the objects of the trust within ambit of power and authority vested in them by virtue of these persents.

18. Any other property and money, which the founder trustee may form time to time deliver to the Trust by the way of registered sale deed, gift deed & stamp duty paid at the time of registration of the documents.



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19. This Trust can join, cooperate or amalgamate this trust with others having similar objects on terms and conditions as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem suitable, with regard to and in conformity with the objectives and nature of the trust in particular.
20. All money and assistance provided by state and the central Government, NABARD, UNO and International agencies and other foreign government can be included in the trust fund.
21. All fees and other charge received may be used for trust Fund.
22. All money received by way of grants, gifts, donation subscription aid, benefaction, bequests to transfer, Provided that no benefactions shall be accepted by the trust which in its opinion involves conditions or obligations opposed to the spirit of the trust.
23. That in fulfillment of the objects of the Trust. That trustees shall be governed by the following provisions:-
 - a) The trustees may purchase lands and building to construct and maintain property in fulfillment of the charitable objects of the trust and perform all ancillary function.
 - b) that trustees may accept gifts of movable and or immovable properties, money, charities etc. in fulfillment of and in consonance with the objects of the



- c) No Part of this Trust Fund including the gift receivable/ received shall be applied for any purpose which is not in furtherance of the charitable purposes and objects of the trust.
 - d) The Trust may convert the corpus of the Trust Fund from one form to the another without changing its basic character.
 - e) May not allow any personal benefit to any of trustees otherwise arising out of contractual obligation.
24. The Trust shall meet whenever the Chief trustee thinks fit and proper. the President of Trust shall call meeting by giving written, notice to all members of the trust, who shall compulsorily meet once in a year, but for smooth functioning of the Trust will hold meeting once in three month, Trust shall be given/provided that in case of emergency the chief Trustee may reduce the period of such intimation to an extent as they deem fit. Three member of the trust shall constitute quorum, no quorum shall be necessary for an adjourned meeting.
25. That chief Trustee shall preside over meeting and in his/her absence the president shall preside over the meeting. Each member of Trust shall have one vote and all other matters be decided by majority votes. In case of equality of votes the chair shall have exclusive right of a vesting vote.
26. That the agenda of the meeting of the Trust shall be intimated to the members before the meeting provided



that a members may move resolution at a meeting of the Trust after giving information of one clear week or with the permission of the Chief Trustee presiding over the meeting. The decision of the Chief trustee in regard to all question of procedure shall be final and binding.

27. That the minutes of the proceeding of a meeting shall be kept on record. All orders and decisions of the Trust shall be authenticated by the chief trustee of any other person authorized by the Trust in this behalf.
28. That the majority of Trustees shall nominate any one amongst nationalized scheduled Bank of State Bank of India & account will be operated by Chief trustee in which all money received shall be deposited. The Trust shall ensure keeping of clear and proper accounts of all receipts and disbursement of the Trust fund and its internal and annual audit by a competent auditor and present the audited accounts of the Trust for acceptance in the Trust annual meeting.
29. That the Trust shall from time to time make rules, regulation as and bye laws as also amend or modify them ad and when founder expedient and necessary for smooth conduct of its business.
30. That in Matters not specifically provided for in deed of Trust provision of the India Trust 1882, shall apply so for as they are in consonance with the charitable purpose and objects of Trust.

31. Nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorize the trustees to do any act which may in any way be construed statutory modifications there of and all the activities of the trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modifications there of.

32. That all cases of and against the trust may sue and be sue in the mane of Trust under the signature of the chief Trustee and in his absence by the other person duty atomized by him/her.
